9 Steps to take after a car accident


1 Stop. If your vehicle is involved in an accident and you don't stop, you may be subject to criminal prosecution. 

2 If anyone is injured, if the total damage to all vehicles appears to be **MORE than \$2,000**, or if you suspect that any of the other drivers involved have been driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol, call 911. Don't try to move anyone injured in the accident! 

3 If no one is injured and total damage to all the vehicles involved appears to be **LESS than \$2,000**, call your local police:

fault before moving your car. Then, move your car or signal other drivers using hazard lights, cones, warning triangles or flares.

5 Write down the names, addresses, phone numbers and insurance information of anyone involved in the accident, including witnesses. 

6 Repairs: it is your right to choose where your vehicle is towed to or repaired. 

7 Seek medical attention within 24 hours so you can be properly treated. If you suspect you may have a concussion, seek medical treatment immediately. 

8 Get legal advice to explore all your legal options as soon as possible. 

9 Call your insurance company and tell them you were in an accident. Do not speak to any insurance company other than your own.
